Ballot Measure 1- Amendments to the ASUWT Constitution

*Abstentions- Any ballot measure left unmarked will be counted as an abstention, defined as the act of declining to vote “yes” or “no” on an action.

For Ballot Measures to be approved, a 60% "Yes" majority of all votes collected on the individual measure must be achieved for an amendment to be made to the constitution.
