Services & Activities Fee (SAF)

- Authorized by state statute
- Supplements state & tuition investment
- Student-directed funding for student activities & programs
- Current SAF fee is \$164/quarter (that's ~\$2.1M annually!)
- Current UWY fee is \$180/quarter

Services & Activities Fee Committee (SAFC)

- 7 voting student members (minimum); referred to Chancellor by ASUWT, appointed by Chancellor
- 4 non-voting ex-officio members (ASUWT, SA, F&A, Faculty)
- 1 non-voting compliance officer
- Comply with Open Public Meetings Act (RCW 42.30)



SAFC Responsibilities

- Review all requests for funding from S&A Fees
- Recommend program priorities and budget levels
- Recommend fee amount, within guidelines
- Serve in an advisory capacity to the Chancellor
- Propose revisions to Bylaws
- Members recuse themselves from voting on funding for programs they are associated with



Initial Requests	\$3,724,722
Proposed Allocation	\$2,808,136
SAF Fee Revenue	\$2,130,000
From Contingency Fund	\$678,136

Contingency Fund	\$1,606,646
Long-Term Fund	\$1,577,284
Tota	\$3,183,930

SAFC Bylaws: unless designated project(s), CF = \$250,000; LTF= \$2,000,000

Current Surplus: \$933,930
