

FAMILY TEAMWORK TIME Plan a meal together Be sure to emphasize the different roles everyone must play in order to have a successful meal. meal planning, shopping, cooking, serving, cleaning up after the meal. when the meal is completed set aside some time to discuss what went well and what could be improved for next time.

How can you teach teamwork at home?

Play games - Games like scavenger hunts, obstacle courses, and relay races can help children learn teamwork, cooperation, and social skills.

Make an obstacle course in your space, and partners take turns guiding their blindfolded partner through the course. The trick is that the person without the blindfold has to guide the blindfolded partner using verbal cues only.
