Senator Wong recommends the leadership program could be cohort based and take courses over a year so they have a chance to cooperate with each other in addition to working with registered student organizations.

Senator Amaya she loves the idea of a leadership minor. She has taken interpersonal relations class and if she could see more interpersonal development like confidence, how you lead and influence people, personal vision and mission, these things could be helpful in being a leader and connecting students with mentors to help them navigate and lead.

Senator Campell likes the idea of a leadership minor. He would like to include some project management, negotiation and conflict resolution, project management as ideas to be included in the program.
