

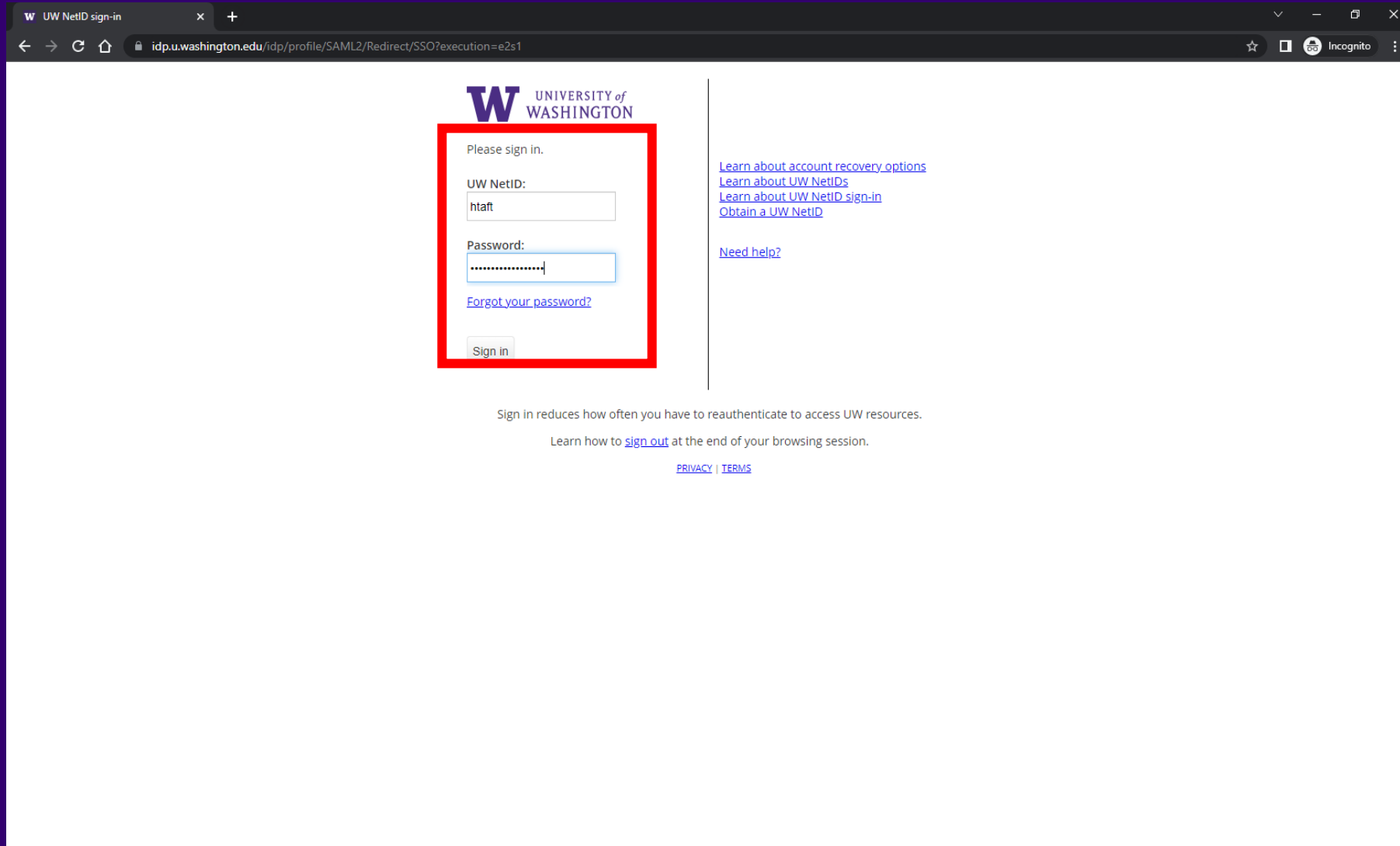

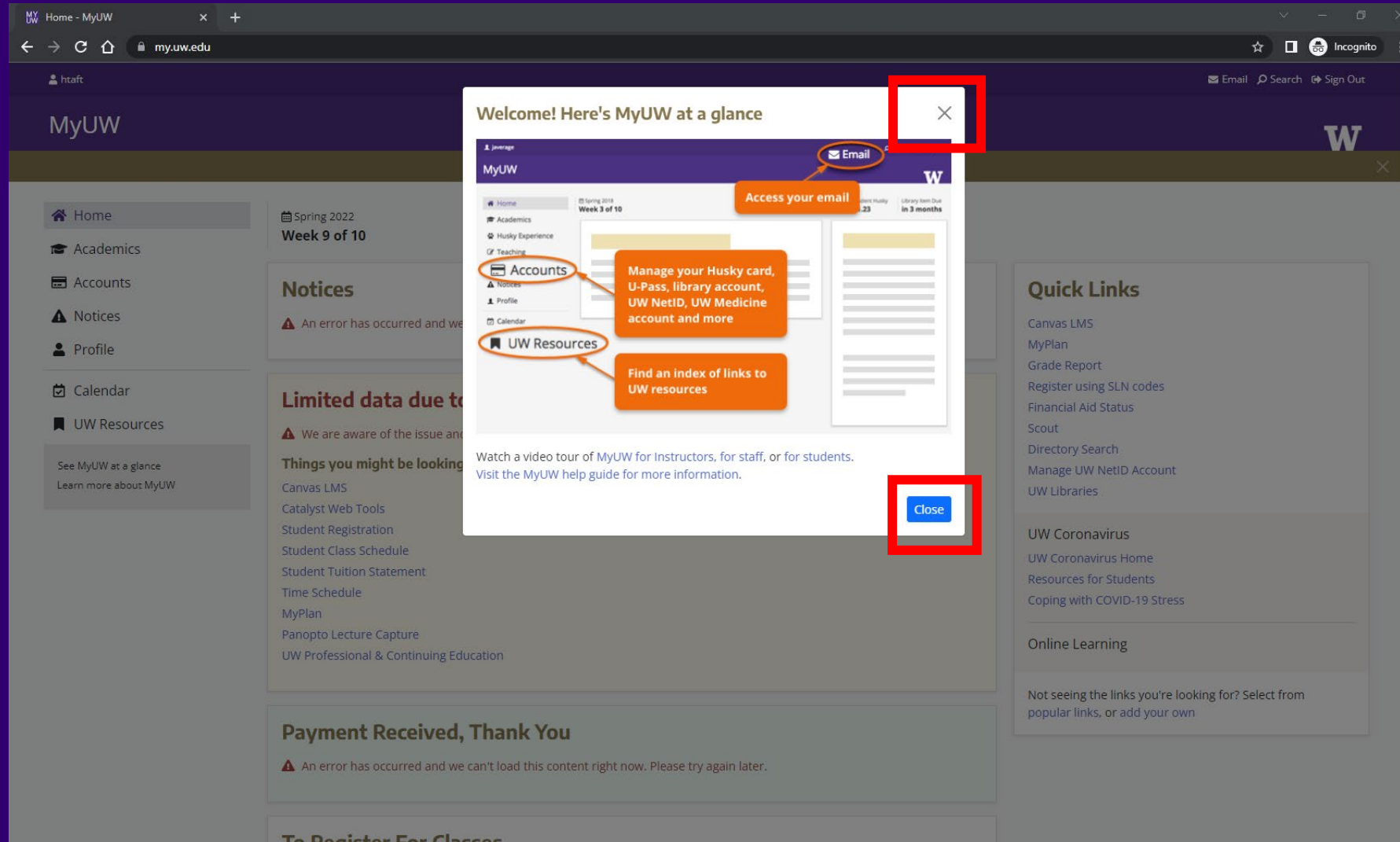

## Consent to Immunization Record Query

The University of Washington requires students to be vaccinated against Measles, Mumps, Meringococcal (ACWY) and COVID-19, with certain exemptions allowed.

If you have received vaccines in the State of Washington, the Washington State Immunization Information System (WIIIS) may contain your immunization records. You may authorize UW to access WIIIS for these records to assist you in satisfying your immunization requirement.

If you authorize UW to query WIIIS and a matching record is located, your immunization requirement may be partially or completely fulfilled without any additional action required.

If you do not authorize UW to query WIIIS, you may still receive immunization records from other sources.

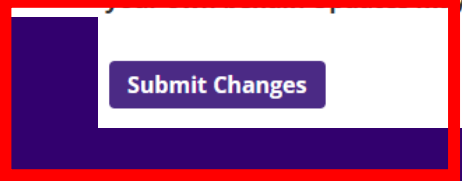

# ACKNOWLEDGE THE FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

## University of Washington Financial Responsibility Agreement

I acknowledge that my right to register is expressly conditioned upon my agreement to pay all the costs of all tuition, fees, and any additional costs incurred by me. I understand and acknowledge that any educational instruction may be presented in a variety of formats (i.e. remote instruction), and I hereby agree to pay all of my University of Washington ("UW") balances, debts, and charges pursuant to UW policies notwithstanding such modifications to the format of instruction. I understand that administrative, clerical, or technical billing errors do not absolve me of this responsibility.

I acknowledge that the UW will notify me of my outstanding charges and debts via email and MyUW. I agree to regularly check both my UW email and/or any emails I provided the UW and MyUW tuition statement.

I agree if any payments made to my student account are returned by the bank for any reason I will repay the original amount of the payment plus a returned payment fee of \$25.00.

I agree that should I fail to pay any past due accounts (by the required due date), a late payment fee may be assessed (\$50 for balances between \$50.00 and \$249.99 and \$120.00 for balances of \$250.00 and greater). Additionally, my right to register for classes and other services, including, but not limited to transcripts and diplomas, may be withheld in accordance with Washington State law and UW policy until I pay all past-due balances.

**Collection Fees:** I understand and accept that if I fail to pay my student account bill or any monies due and owing the UW by the scheduled due date, and fail to make acceptable payment arrangements to bring my account current, the UW may refer my delinquent account to a collection agency. I further understand that if the UW refers my student account balance to a third party for collection, a collection fee will be assessed and will be due in full at the time of the referral to the third party. The fee will be based on a percentage at a maximum of 40% of the debt as authorized by RCW 19.16.500, and may include reasonable costs and expenses including attorney's fees. Finally, I understand that my delinquent account may be reported to one or more of the national credit bureaus.

I authorize the UW and their respective agents and contractors to contact me regarding any loan or debt, including repayment of my loan or debt to my UW email or other email provided the UW and to my current or any future number that I provide for my cellular phone or other wireless device using automated telephone dialing equipment or artificial or pre-recorded voice or text messages.

*The provisions of this Financial Responsibility Agreement will be governed by the laws of the State of Washington and applicable laws of the United States, without regard to conflict of law rules. I agree that any action arising out of or relating to this agreement be brought in the state courts located in King County, Washington. I consent to the jurisdiction and venue of these courts.*

I agree to notify the UW within 30 days after my local or permanent address changes. While I am a UW student, I will update my address through the MyUW portal.

# ACKNOWLEDGE FERPA NOTICE

## UW Notification of Rights under FERPA for Postsecondary Institutions

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords eligible students certain rights with respect to their education records. (An "eligible student" under FERPA is a student who is 18 years of age or older or who attends a postsecondary institution at any age.)

Additional information about FERPA for students can be found on the webpage of the Office of the University Registrar: <https://registrar.washington.edu/students/ferpa>. That page includes information about how to restrict the release of directory information, and other FERPA resources. Directory information at the University of Washington is defined as a student's name, address, email address, telephone numbers, major, and minor field(s) of study (including pre-major or undeclared), class, date of birth, enrollment status (e.g. graduate, undergraduate, professional, post-baccalaureate, or non-matriculated student, full- or part-time), participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height if the student is a member of an intercollegiate athletic team, dates of attendance, degrees, honors, and awards received, and the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student. You may opt out of directory information about you being released using the tools available in MyUW. Opting out will not prevent information about you that falls within directory information from being released as otherwise allowed or required by law.

The rights provided by FERPA include:

1. The right to inspect and review your education records within 45 days after the day the University of Washington receives a request for access. You should submit to the registrar, dean, head of the academic department a written request that identifies the record(s) you wish to inspect. The school official will make arrangements for access and notify you of the time and place where the records may be inspected. If the records are not maintained by the school official to whom the request was submitted, that official should advise you of the correct official to whom the request should be addressed.
2. The right to request the amendment of your education records that you believe are inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of your privacy rights under FERPA. This process cannot be used to challenge grades.  
  
A student who wishes to ask the University to amend a record should write the school official responsible for the record, clearly identify the part of the record the student wants changed, and specify why it should be changed.  
  
If the University decides not to amend the record as requested, you will be notified in writing of the decision and your right to request a hearing regarding the request for amendment.
3. The right to provide written consent before the University discloses personally identifiable information (PII) from your education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.

The University discloses education records without a student's prior written consent under the FERPA exception for disclosure to school officials with legitimate educational interests. School officials include faculty, instructors, staff, student employees, volunteers, third party contractors, and any individual UW has determined to have legitimate educational interests in accessing education records. An individual has a legitimate educational interest when they need access to the education record to perform their official duties; not to satisfy curiosity or other non-job related interests.

Upon request, the school also discloses education records without consent to officials of another school in which a student seeks or intends to enroll.

4. The right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education concerning alleged failures by the University to comply with the requirements of FERPA. The name and address of the office that administers FERPA is:




