The figures in this report are descriptive statistics that outline student responses to questions in the New Student Survey.


How was the survey developed?


We had 1,235 responses to this survey of incoming student.

What is the highest degree you hope to attain?




Having said you are seeking a degree, how long do you intend to stay at UW Tacoma? (Please select one answer)

Where are you in the process of selecting a major?












Do you plan to participate in a study abroad program while at UW Tacoma?




Why don't you plan on participating in a study abroad program?





How satisfied are you with the financial aid amount you are receiving from UW Tacoma? (Mark one)







What is your most likely mode of transportation?



Where do you plan to live while enrolled at UW Tacoma?




What are the main reasons for your decision to live off campus?




Which of these statements best describes the food eaten in your household in the last 12 months:




If more on-campus housing were available (dorms), how likely is it that you would consider living on-campus?



Are you planning on staying in the Puget Sound area after completing your education?





What is your personal share of monthly rent / housing costs excluding utilities for the current academic year?












